It's OK to keep scanned DLs

Driving licence, registration certificate stored in Aadhaar-linked Digilocker will be accepted

Transport and Road Safety Commissioner B Dayananda has issued an order notifying that Driving Licence (DL), Registration Certificate (RC) and Emission Certificate (EC) downloaded by citizens into their Digilocker will be deemed to be original certificates and will be treated on par with certificates issued by the department in the form of smart card or paper form.

He clarified that it doesn't apply to cases where DLs or RCs have to be seized by law enforcement authorities as per Motor Vehicles Act and Rules.

The Ministry of Electronics and IT, Government of India has framed a Digilocker Authority on July 21, 2016. The authority has launched the Digilocker platform which is a digital repository of documents and certificates issued to a citizen, linked to his/her Aadhaar number. Digilocker platform has now the facility to pull a citizen's DL and RC by way of its integration with the ministry of Road Transport, Government of India. These legal copies available on Digilocker are mandated as original documents as per the IT Act-2000, the commissioner explained.

The government of Karnataka (e-Governance Department) has now linked the state transport department with Digilocker which will enable citizens to download their DLs, RCs and emission certificates to their digilocker account as digilocker is linked to the citizen's identity has been authenticated with the help of Aadhaar and department data base, he added.

You won't need to show the smart card of paper licences to the traffic cops anymore, you can show it to the documents in your Digilocker account

Show when asked
Vehicle riders or owners should show their documents stored in Digilocker to the enforcement authorities like police whenever they demanded. Hence, the transport department has issued an order to treat the documents in Digilocker should on par with original documents. However, it will not apply for cases such as drunk and drive as original driving licenses will have to be seized.

GRIEVANCES, ANYONE?
Transport department has opened a call centre for redressal of public grievances. The centre will operate from 9 am to 6 pm except Sunday and government holidays. It will accept grievances, suggestions coming from social media such as Whatsapp, facebook, twitter and e-mail along with calls. HOW TO GET A DIGILOCKER
For getting the digital RC & DL, users should ensure their Aadhaar number is linked with their Digilocker account. Once this is done, they can go to the "Pull Partner Documents" section, select the issuer & document type and enter the document details asked for. This will allow them to fetch their document from the MoRTH database. Once the document is fetched, users can save a permanent link (URI) to this digital document in their "Issued Documents" section for later reuse.
